GUIDELINES AND POLICIES FOR MINISTERS OF HOSPITALITY

Ministers of Hospitality are expected to comply with the Guidelines and Policies of Grace in Action.

- First and foremost, we are to model the life of Jesus Christ.
- We are His "hands, feet, eyes, ears, and heart."
- We seek to maintain an atmosphere of reverence and respect—a place of safety and rest.
- God is the "cure giver." We offer love and hope but are careful not to enable.
- We listen for our guest's needs, concerns, and fears (whether spoken or unspoken) either for the purpose of intercessory prayer for that individual or to determine the direction of service needed.
- We are here to support and encourage each other in this ministry of service.
- We treat others with gentleness and patience and refrain from inappropriate language and dispute.
- If you feel "moved" by something that happens and/or is said and would like someone to pray with you or for you, please let us know.
- Be diligent and intentional about your own spiritual life. This would include prayerfully
 preparing as you go out into the world and lifting of oppression and burdens at the close of
 the day.

Affiliation and Representation

When you are working directly with Grace in Action (on site or at specific functions) you are a representative of this ministry. Additionally, if you are NOT working directly with Grace in Action (when interacting with those in need), please do not "assume" that your actions are specifically approved by this ministry.

Appropriate Attire

Please do not wear any low cut or revealing shirts, short shorts, or clothing with potentially offensive slogans or logos. Shoes or sandals must be worn. Please remember how we present ourselves is also a "witness" to our guests.

Confidentiality

Information pertaining to the guests of Grace in Action obtained by a Minister of Hospitality must be treated as confidential and not shared beyond what is necessary to assist the individual except in the following cases:

- If a person is an imminent danger to themselves or others (contact the Director immediately).
- In the case of suspected child abuse, information must be passed on to authorized authorities, as we are mandated reporters.

Representation

Only Board-designated approved individuals shall represent Grace in Action at functions with other nonprofit agencies, private companies and government entities or public correspondence. Ministers of Hospitality may only use the Grace in Action name for fundraising when they have received written authorization from the Board of Directors.

Behavioral Expectations

Inappropriate, threatening, dangerous, or illegal activity by guests is not acceptable to Grace in Action and shall be reported immediately to the Director.

Fraternization with the guests is prohibited. No dating, exchange of personal information (i.e. phone number or address), offering rides, etc. Please use common sense, prayer and discernment when interacting with the guests. This is for your benefit and for the benefit of Grace in Action and our guests.

If you observe or encounter any "challenges" (inappropriate behavior) from the guests, or are in ANY way uncomfortable with your role as a Minister of Hospitality, please speak to the Director immediately about the issue. No concern is too insignificant to express.

Please do not offer cash support to guests. On occasion, a "long time guest" may receive financial support from Grace in Action after careful discernment and interview with the Director regarding a specific need. Needs of guests should be referred to the Director.

Requirements

A Minister of Hospitality must:

- Be at least 18-years old and assigned to a veteran Minister of Hospitality for training.
- Serve a minimum of at least six months in the organization (or one quarter for students).
- Enlist to work a regularly-scheduled task or activity.
- Complete and submit the first two pages of the application and maintain this agreement form for you own records.

Ministers of Hospitality are encouraged to support the ministry by attending fundraising and other organizational events.
